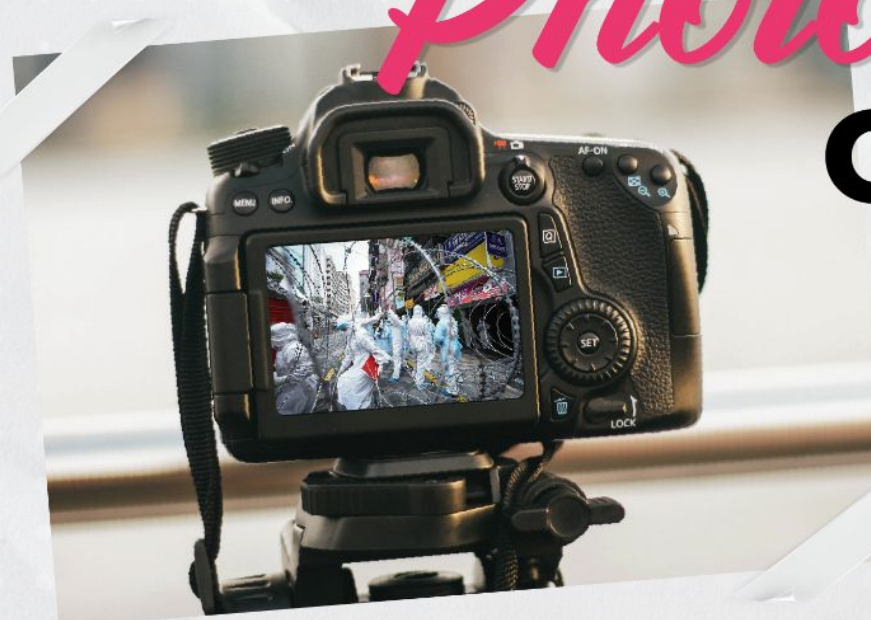

TOPIC AND ARTWORK CRITERIA

Topic

Prepared, based on the topic
**”Covid-19: The Unsung
Heroes”**

Artwork Criteria:

- i. Format: Digital (JPEG)
- ii. Resolution: 300 dpi (must not be bigger than 50MB, highest “*compressed format*” JPEG and not be lower than 7MB).
- iii. The title given must be complete, accurate and the author must provide sufficient details.
- iv. Maximum 3 entries / works for each participant.
- v. The artwork must be original and not processed using any application and the property of the students.

COMPETITION THEME:

“COVID-19: THE UNSUNG HEROES”

Not to be forgotten, the police, journalists and even those who are at high risk of getting and spreading Covid-19 infection.

Thus, with humility, great sacrifice, dedication, commitment and unwavering effort in managing COVID-19, often risking their own life and the sake of the country, we decided to make this title the main theme of this competition as a sign of appreciation towards our country's heroes.



TERMS AND REGULATIONS

Participants

- Open to all secondary schools students, **Form 4, 5 dan 6** in Perak.
- This competition is open to **all Pre-U students** in Malaysia.
- Each school is encouraged **to submit as many entries** as possible.
- **10 finalists will be selected** and the work will be on display on the day of the prize giving.



Conditions

- In this competition, participants are required to exhibit works that **tell the story of the front-liners** who sacrifices their life for Covid-19 pandemic.
- The artworks are required to be based on the theme that has been set, namely "**Covid-19: The Unsung Heroes**".
- The artworks are not necessarily related to the daily tasks of the front line, but can also be applied to the essence related to one's sacrifice in dealing with this pandemic.
- Each entry must emphasise the values of sensitivity of the Malaysian community.
- Participants can use any medium, either a DSLR camera or a mobile phone.



Winners

- The winners will be announced on the mentioned date and the jury's decision is final.
- Only 10 selected participants will be invited on the day of the prize giving.
- Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third place winners. 3 consolation prizes are also available.
