Entry Requirements

Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM)

Pass STPM or its equivalent with a minimum of Grade C (GPA 2.00) in two (2) subjects; a credit in Mathematics and Science and a pass in English at SPM level.

A Level

Pass A-Level with passes in two (2) subjects, including a credit in Mathematics and Science; a pass in English at "O" level.

Matriculation / Foundation

Pass recognised Matriculation / Foundation with a minimum CGPA 2.0 out of 4.00 and credits in Mathematics and Science and pass English at SPM level.

Diploma

Pass Diploma programme (Level 4, MQF) with a minimum CGPA 2.00 out of 4.00 and credit in Mathematics and Science and pass English at SPM Level; OR

Pass Diploma in Psychology programme (Level 4, MQF) with at least CGPA 2.00 out of 4.00; OR

Unified Examination Certificate (UEC)

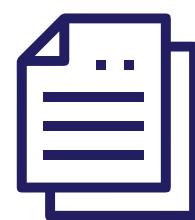
Pass the Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) with a minimum of Grade B in five (5) subjects including Mathematics, Science and English.
