Under this committee, four clusters have been established, each focusing on different areas of concern within the university to plan and implement initiatives aligned with the Sustainable Development Goals. These clusters are led by members of the QIU SDG Steering Committee, though cluster participants are not required to be committee members. This approach is intended to broaden staff involvement across diverse backgrounds. Student participation is also encouraged within these clusters.

The four clusters and their objectives are:

1 EDUCATION	To provide students and the local community with the knowledge, skills, and motivation to understand and address the challenges of the SDGs and to empower and mobilise them for action.
2 RESEARCH	To research the causes behind SDG-related issues and craft solutions.
3 OPERATIONS	To align all University Policies, procedures, and activities with the SDGs.
4 LEADERSHIP	To create awareness and seek opportunities to engage at the city, state, national, and international level as an advocate for sustainable development.

A Diversity, and Equality sub-committee was established to provide guidance on and implement policies, programs, and training focused on diversity, equity, inclusion, and human rights on campus. This six-member committee includes the Director of the Student Life Division, Deputy COO, Director of the Human Resource Division, Bursar, Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences, and the Deputy Registrar. The committee collaborates with various departments, leadership, and staff to foster an inclusive and diverse environment where everyone has the opportunity to thrive.





INTRODUCTION

The QIU SDG Secretariat is pleased to share the 2024 Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Steering Committee Report for Quest International University. This document presents a unified overview of impactful initiatives across the Education, Research, Operations and Leadership Clusters. It is a quad-cluster synthesis of SDG-aligned initiatives across these domains. Activities spanned environmental stewardship, civic engagement, leadership capacity-building, financial literacy, and a strong research portfolio addressing pressing local and global challenges. Emphasis was placed on SDG 3 (Good Health), SDG 4 (Quality Education), SDG 8 (Decent Work), SDG 9 (Industry & Innovation), SDG 13 (Climate Action), and SDG 17 (Partnerships), affirming QIU's mission to contribute meaningfully to national development and global priorities.

KEY HIGHLIGHTS

Environmental Citizenship

Over 340 trees were planted and a major clean-up initiative was implemented under the Education Cluster. This fostered civic responsibility and ecosystem restoration (SDGs 13, 14, 15).







Leadership Development

Twelve emerging leaders were trained which will culminate in real-world projects in 2025 (SDG 4).



Financial Literacy & Community Engagement

Targeted outreach and collaborations (e.g., with MFPC) empowered youth and underserved communities to navigate economic realities (SDGs 1, 4, 8).







Research Impact

With over 90 research projects aligned to 9 major SDGs, QIU's academic community demonstrated innovation in health sciences, education, Al, biotechnology, and environmental sustainability.

Besides all these activities, QIU staff were also involved in blood donation campaigns. The campaigns were conducted in collaboration with Blood Transfusion Department, HRPB, AEON Kinta City and AEON Big Falim. In the 18 campaigns conducted, a total of 420 bags of blood was collected.

QIU staff were also involved in providing meals for the homeless and poor. A total of 1,820 hot meals were served as part of the Soup Kitchen Initiative.
